Subsidised service has been provided by MNLC for very many years with recipients historically paying £3.50/£4.00 per week and Lions paying between £1-£3 subsidy per meal to the Fish & Chip provider.  During the pandemic the service ran uninterrupted for 18 months (Oct 19 – April 21) with weekly delivery numbers reaching 50/60 recipients from previous 30/35, with NTC very kindly supporting our efforts with a £1,500 grant awarded in October 2020 which was fully utilised. A further grant of £400 was provided last year (22/23) when Norton deliveries averaged between 25/30 per week. In view of the current ongoing substantially higher inflationary and food stuff price increases, increased fish and chip prices were charged by the provider last year resulting in a 50p increase in the charge to recipients alongside increased MNLC subsidy costs to ensure Norton elderly, infirm and vulnerable recipients continue to enjoy a weekly hot meal and regular contact from our members. A further price increase by the provider is expected from October 23.

## LIONS CLUB

#### REPORT BY TRUSTEES

In the year ended 30 June 2022 the Club received income from donations, subscriptions and fund-raising initiatives totalling £34,203 as shown individually within the annual accounts.

During the year, a recovery of our usual Welfare activities programme took place as legal restrictions relating to the Coronavirus Pandemic were eased.

On-line donation facilities via the Donate National Funding Scheme continued to attract financial donations from the public but on a much lower scale to the previous year; our much-anticipated Lions Santa Sleigh had another successful outing and we continued with our (virtual) Lions Summer Lunch in aid of Yorkshire Air Ambulance. In addition we ran a successful Race Night for the first time since 2018.

Weekly Fish and Chip deliveries for the elderly and infirm across our district continued to be undertaken throughout, with a substantial increase in demand seen alongside delivery of Community Kitchen food parcels providing a vital service for vulnerable residents. Grant support for the Lions Fish and Chips subsidy costs during the year was received from Malton Town Council (£269.75) with further grant monies received from both Ryedale District Council (£1,000) towards a new Sleigh Storage Tent and North Yorkshire County Council (£1,000) towards a new "Library of Things" initiative being set up by Lions Members all of which has been very much appreciated.

We were also delighted to once again undertake our popular daffodil run for elderly residents and following Malton Town Council previously providing a grant, arrangements to hold a Malton Old Folks Summer Party are currently in hand for July 2022.

A Community Fund grant scheme has once again supported local organisations badly affected by the Pandemic shutdowns; continuing assistance with the on-going running of the Ryedale Free Fridge scheme to utilise surplus food for the needy and reduce local food waste; caravan holidays for local holidays in Filey; providing grant assistance to local Statutory and other support agencies dealing with requests from individuals for carpets, heating support and other household items; establishment of storage facilities to house donated household items and other goods for which no payment is made. In total we spent £26,877.

The Club's financial position has remained healthy and despite reduced membership, we welcomed the return of face-to-face Club meetings during the year.

Total funds available for future disbursement in line with our CIO activity constitution at the yearend amounted to £29,278.

No remuneration or other benefits from employment with the Charity or a related entity was received by the Trustees. £932 was paid out to ten trustees/members in respect of travel, administrative expenses, and the Presidents other costs. Of these expenses, £519 was donated back to the charity reducing the net cost to £413.
