Invitations:

Other issues related to Norton:

BP Garage & supermarket:

I emailed the contractors re:completion date for this project and the untidy state of the conifer hedge adjacent to Springfield Garth. The response was that the project is due for completion around the end of October so there has been some slippage and the conifers will be cut back at the end of September improving the pavement access on Springfield Garth.

Members will also be aware of the recent resurfacing near the site – pity this didn't extend to other areas of Welham Road.

Norton Road:

There has been a lot of comment on social media and on the street about the introduction of the trial one way system on Norton Road/Blackboards, especially so soon after the EA works. Please bear in mind that this trial has been planned for several years now and repeatedly delayed, so good to see it finally in place – however I can see no reason why it isn't being trialled in conjunction with the proposed traffic lights at the level crossing.
