Allotment Pot Holes

The roadway at the allotments is full of deep potholes. We are unable to find the previous clerks quote for full tarmacadam but believe this was circa £30,000 - £40,000. The allotment holders association have done some research into the aggregate required, and have, in the past, kindly filled the holes for us.

They require 20 Tonnes of 20/40 Limestone and 20 Tonnes of Roadway Planings.

The 20/40 is a larger aggregate to go in the bottom of the holes, the Roadway Planings are softer, and a smaller gradient for the infilling the top.

The cost of 20 Tonnes of 20/40 Limestone is £477.00 + Vat, delivered.

The cost of 20 Tonnes of Roadway Planings is £460.00 + Vat, delivered.

Total £937.00 + Vat

This is not a permanent solution this but would go some way to improve the situation for a good 3 to 4 years. The allotment holders association have the necessary machinery and have undertaken work like this for us on our behalf in the past.

For Resolution

It is our recommendation that members sanction the £937.00 + VAT (£1,000 + VAT) so we can improve the roadway situation at the allotments.
