Invitations:

- Communication with NYC are: one way on Norton Road I have heard from Cllr Duncan following the Q at last months meeting on the removal of the one way system on Norton Road. Still awaiting final approval but it looks likely that the one way will remain in place while the results of the trial are assessed which is a sensible result.
- Communication with Yorkshire Water re permanent pumping solution for Nortons ongoing flood problems – STILL awaiting a response from Yorkshire Water
